Overview of Motivational Interviewing

Wednesday, October 3, 2018

This presentation examines the basis, definition, goals and key elements of Motivational Interviewing (MI) as an approach to help people decide to make behavioral changes.

Participants will be able to experience and contrast traditional approaches to behavior change to those proposed by MI. They will review the underlying spirit that drives MI interventions and have an opportunity to apply some of the basic strategies of MI and discuss how these could be useful in their interactions with people receiving behavioral healthcare services.

Carol J. Auerbach, MA, MINT – is a Motivational Interviewing Network Trainer (MINT) and an instructor in the Division of Behavioral Healthcare Education of the Department of Psychiatry. Her areas of teaching include motivational interviewing, suicide prevention, mindfulness, substance use disorders and recovery-oriented practice. Additionally, she is a therapist whose areas of clinical practice have included individual and group therapy for adults with serious psychiatric and/or substance use disorders.
