This position evaluates students referred for treatment, develops and evaluates individualized treatment pans, conducts psychotherapy, documents progress, and coordinates with family and other service providers. The School Therapist additionally provides family support to promote social development, academic engagement and emotional regulation of the child; crisis intervention therapy, and attends in-services and required trainings.
